Wildlife safari

- ✿ In the last activity, 'What habitats are here', you explored your natural surroundings and found different habitats, such as woodland, meadow, river or pond.
- ✿ Now you are going to explore those habitats and see what wild plants and animals are living there.
- ✿ Your teacher will divide you into teams. Each team will be given a different group of living things to look for. These groups are:

Plants

Plants are easy to find, but there are a lot of different ones, and identifying them can be difficult.

Trees

Trees are also easy to find. Look at the shape of the leaves to identify them.

Birds

Some birds are easier to see than others. Binoculars will help. Listen carefully to their songs.

Minibeasts

Look carefully in lots of different places - in long grass, in soil, in the leaves of trees, under logs and stones.
