Nature cameras

- ✿ First, find a partner.
- ✿ Decide who will be the 'camera', and who will be the 'photographer'.
- ✿ The person who is the camera closes their eyes.
- ✿ The photographer points the camera at something they want to take a picture of.
- ✿ Photographers can move their cameras around, make them kneel or lie down, move them close to something, or put them at an angle.
- ✿ When the photographer has positioned the camera, they say 'CLICK!' - this is the camera button being pressed.
- ✿ The camera opens their eyes, **JUST FOR A SECOND**, then closes them again. This is the photograph being taken.
- ✿ The photographer turns them around so they are facing away from the thing they took a photograph of.
- ✿ The camera opens their eyes and draws what they saw for the second that their eyes were open in the photo' frame below.
- ✿ Compare the photograph to the real thing - which details did they remember?

Then swap over and do it again!
