## Sound maps

- ✿ The box below is your sound map.
- ✿ The smiley face right in the middle of the map is you.
- ✿ Be very, very quiet and listen for sounds. It might help to close your eyes while you listen.
- ✿ When you hear a sound, think about how you would write or draw it on your map. If you hear a bird, you could draw a bird or write the word 'bird'.
- ✿ You need to draw or write the sound in the right place on the map. Remember, the smiley face in the middle is you. Was the sound in front of you, behind, to the left or to the right? The words on the map will help you to do this.
- ✿ How close was the sound? Should it be near or far from the smiley face?

*You can draw sound maps for as long as you want. If one map gets full, just start another one on a blank sheet of paper (remember to write on the words to help).*
