### Birds

Name of bird	Food
<b>Collared dove</b>	Seeds, berries
<b>Wren</b>	Beetles, spiders, ants
<b>Dunnock</b>	Small insects, seeds
<b>Robin</b>	Insects, worms, berries
<b>Blackbird</b>	Insects, worms, berries
<b>Thrush</b>	Snails, slugs, berries
<b>Blue tit</b>	Caterpillars, seeds
<b>Chaffinch</b>	Seeds, insects, berries
<b>Greenfinch</b>	Flower buds, seeds
<b>Sparrow</b>	Seeds, insects, buds

### Mammals

Name of mammal	Food
<b>Hedgehog</b>	Slugs, worms
<b>Wood mouse</b>	Seeds, shoots, buds
<b>Water vole</b>	Waterside plants
<b>Field vole</b>	Grass, roots, bark
<b>Squirrel</b>	Nuts, bark
<b>Pipistrelle bat</b>	Small flies and moths
